**SUBJECT: Amendment #3B to Senior Citizens Agreement to Incorporate CARES funds
for Fiscal Year 2020**

Request: Council authorization to execute Amendment No. 3B to the grant agreement with the Bluegrass Area Development District to incorporate an increase of federal funds in the amount of \$92,682.59 reflecting an appropriation from the CARES Act for operation of the Senior Citizens Center.

Purpose of Request: On June 20, 2019 (Resolution No. 342-2019), Council approved acceptance of federal and state funds in the amount of \$123,000 from the Bluegrass Area Development District for the operation of the Lexington Senior Citizens Center in FY 2020.

On August 29, 2019 (Resolution 458-2019), Council authorized an amendment to the grant agreement. The original grant agreement did not specify the breakdown of eligible reimbursable expenses. An amendment incorporated the budget and breakdown of eligible costs into the agreement.

On March 19, 2020 (Resolution 151-2020) Council authorized amendment to the grant agreement to increase in state funding in the budget for operation of the Senior Citizens Center in FY 2020.

Another amendment is requested that will incorporate a \$92,682.59 increase in federal funding.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? The federal award increased by \$92,682.59 for Fiscal Year 2020.

Are the funds budgeted? BA 10689 is in process.
