**SUBJECT:** Hazard Mitigation Grant Modification No. 1 for Emergency Generator

**Project at the Lexington Fayette Animal Care and Control (LFACC)** 

**Request:** Council authorization to execute Modification No. 1 to agreement with the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management to include "if applicable" to the Agency Terms and Conditions and to extend the period of performance to June 30, 2034 for the Emergency Generator Project Lexington Fayette Animal Care and Control (LFACC).

**Purpose of Request:** On February 10, 2022 (Resolution 062-2022) Council approved acceptance of award in the amount of \$88,229.25 from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and \$14,116.68 from the state and local match of \$15,293.07 to purchase a generator for the Lexington-Fayette Animal Care and Control Facility. On June 23, 2022 (Resolution 335-2022), Council approved to execute amendment to the agreement to extend the period of performance to June 30, 2024. On December 1, 2022 (Resolution 651-2022), Council approved to accept additional amount of \$15,000 in federal funds from FEMA and \$2,400 non-federal share from the state, local match of \$2,600 for a total project cost of \$137,639.

The Kentucky Emergency Management Agency has modified agreement to add "if applicable" Agency Terms and Conditions and extend the period of performance to June 30, 2034.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? There is no budgetary impact. No anticipated cost in future budget years.

**Are the funds budgeted?** All grant funds are budgeted.
