City of Lexington, KY /ICC Licensing Agreement (May 2016)

Copyright © 2012 by, or licensed to, ICC (ALL RIGHTS RESERVED); licensed to Lexington Fayette Urban County, Division of Building Inspection pursuant to License Agreement. No further reproductions authorized. Any unauthorized reproduction or distribution is a violation of the federal copyright act and the license agreement, and subject to civil and criminal penalties thereunder.

- 2) ICC will grant Lexington a non-revocable license to either post the Codes on its internal computer system or install them on individual employee devices. This license is limited to twenty-five (25) users. ICC further more limits such access to Lexington employees only.
 - a) Lexington may excerpt code provisions from the PDF and paste them into business documents used to enforce the Code. No other reproduction is authorized.
 - **b**) Lexington acknowledges that the Codes are copyrighted material. Lexington agrees not to distribute, sublicense or sell any of the copyrighted material contained in the Codes except as specified in this agreement. Lexington may not assign any rights granted herein, without the written consent of the ICC.
 - c) Lexington is responsible for informing employees that the PDF is licensed to Lexington and not the individual employee.
- 3) Lexington shall pay ICC a total of \$ 5,500.00 for the services and license listed above. ICC shall invoice Lexington within 30 days of executing this Agreement. The files shall be delivered to: deweyc@lexingtonky.gov
