SUBJECT Rubber Modified Asphalt Grant Award

Request:

Council authorization to accept award in the amount of \$98,851 from the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet's Rubber Modified Asphalt Grant Program to facilitate the thin lift overlay of Southland Drive in the Division of Streets and Roads.

Purpose of Request:

On April 11, 2019 (Resolution 191-2019), the Division of Streets and Roads was authorized by Council to submit an application requesting state funding from the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet to facilitate the thin lift overlay of Southland Drive in two sections using rubber modified asphalt in one section and conventional asphalt in the other for comparison and evaluation.

Funds will be used entirely to purchase and lay the rubber modified asphalt. LFUCG Division of Streets and Roads will fund any pre-work repairs, milling, striping, signage, and any overages on both demonstration sections of roadway.

Funding for this grant comes from the Rubber Modified Asphalt Grant Program established in KRS 224.50-878.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

State funding is \$98,951. Funds for future fiscal years are depended upon available state funds.

Are the funds budgeted?

Budget amendment for Fiscal Year 2020 is in process.
