Request Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for additional federal funds in the amount \$22,200 for design of Town Branch Trail Crossing at Old Frankfort Pike and McConnell Springs Drive under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality

(CMAQ) Program

On May 7, 2015 (Resolution 264-2015), Council approved acceptance of federal funds in the amount of \$43,000 under the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program for design of a crossing that will provide a safe, at-grade crossing of Old Frankfort Pike at McConnell Springs Drive.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG an additional \$22,200 in federal funds for the design of this project. An additional \$5,550 in match is required. This match will be provided by the Municipal Aid Program. Total design cost is now \$81,500 (\$65,200 federal and \$16,300 local match.

Council authorization to execute the amendment to the agreement is hereby requested.
