

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-305(1) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO THE SPECIAL EVENTS COMMISSION TO CHANGE THE DUTIES TO REVIEWING APPLICATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 2-305(2) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO THE SPECIAL EVENTS COMMISSION FOR THE COMMISSION TO COORDINATE EVENT APPLICATIONS WITH OTHER GOVERNMENTAL DIVISIONS AS NECESSARY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 – That Section 2-305(1) and 2-305(2) of the Code of Ordinances of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-305. Duties.

The special events commission shall perform the following duties:

- (1) The commission shall be responsible for reviewing applications on the "Fourth of July Festival," "New Year's Eve Celebration," and other special events, including races, parades, art fairs, etc.
- (2) The commission shall coordinate its event applications with urban county government divisions as necessary.
- (3) The commission may establish committees, headed by commission members, which shall include interested members of the public, for the purpose of carrying out the duties as set forth herein.
- (4) The commission may perform any other act necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes of this section.

Section 2 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
