Request:

The Division of Enhanced 911 is requesting a resolution authorizing the Mayor to change street names and/or individual numbers of addresses within the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th Council Districts.

The official date of change should be thirty (30) days from the date of passage to allow for new sign placement, utility and Post Office notifications as well as final citizen notification.
