REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT AWARD FOR POLICE TRAINING INCENTIVE GRANT FOR FY 2015 FROM THE KENTUCKY JUSTICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY CABINET UNDER THE KENTUCKY LAW ENFORCEMENT FOUNDATION PROGRAM FUND

Police Training Incentive funds are used to provide eligible police officers with supplemental pay for participation in training programs. Supplemental pay in the amount of \$3,100.00 for each eligible officer (570 sworm positions) is provided for a total of \$1,767,000. In addition, the program contributes 30.5758% of that total towards the pension of participants, totaling 540,270. Funds total \$2,307,270 with no local match required. Funds are from the state of Kentucky and are awarded by the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet from the Kentucky Law Enforcement Foundation Program Fund.
