Administrative Synopsis - New Business Items

- A** [0348-12](#) Authorization to amend the facilities maintenance agreement with Meridian Management Corporation for facility management services at the Fayette County Courthouses located at 120 & 150 North Limestone Street. (L348-12) (Hamilton).
This is a request to amend the facilities maintenance agreement with Meridian Management Corporation for facility management services at the Fayette County Courthouses located at 120 & 150 North Limestone Street. The amendment will extend the contract term for six (6) additional months, beginning July 13, 2012 through January 12, 2013 at an increase in cost of \$3,500.00 per month. Funds are budgeted.
- B** [0436-12](#) Authorization to approve a contract with The Prudential Insurance Company of America for Group Life Insurance for all LFUCG employees, effective January 1, 2012. (L436-12) (Walters/Graham)
This is a request to approve a contract with The Prudential Insurance Company of America for Group Life Insurance for all LFUCG employees, effective January 1, 2012. Funds are budgeted.
- C** [0438-12](#) Authorization to approve an agreement with Cassidian Corporation for the public safety grade 800 MHz digital trunked radio infrastructure with eight (8) channels. The terms of the agreement include a commitment by Cassidian to accept all FCC fines in the event the Division of Police is not in compliance with the FCC narrowband requirement and waivers are not granted by January 1, 2013. (L438-12) (Bastin/Mason)
This is a request to approve an agreement with Cassidian Corporation for the public safety grade 800 MHz digital trunked radio infrastructure with eight (8) channels. The terms of the agreement include a commitment by Cassidian to accept all FCC fines in the event the Division of Police is not in compliance with the FCC narrowband requirement and waivers are not granted by January 1, 2013. The cost is \$4,762,236. Funds are budgeted. The agreement is pending review by the Department of Law.
- D** [0452-12](#) Authorization to execute Contract Addendum for Fiscal Year 2012 with the Lexington-Fayette County Health Department for

the Home Network Project at the Family Care Center. (L452-12) (Gooding/Mills)

This is a request to execute Contract Addendum for Fiscal Year 2012 with the Lexington-Fayette County Health Department providing additional federal and state funds in the amount of \$41,208 for the Home Network Project at the Family Care Center.

E [0454-12](#) Authorization to accept award from the Commission on Fire Protection, Personnel, Standards, and Education for Training Incentive for Firefighters. (L454-12) (Gooding/Mason)

This is a request to accept award of \$2,006,685 in FY 2013 funds from the Commission on Fire Protection, Personnel, Standards, and Education for Training Incentive for Firefighters. No local match required.

F [0453-12](#) Authorization to accept award for Police Training Incentive Grant for FY 2013 from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet. (L453-12) (Gooding/Mason)

This is a request to accept award for Police Training Incentive Grant for FY 2013 from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet. Funds total \$2,120,336. No local match required.

G [0460-12](#) Authorization to accept professional services agreement for the Sanitary Sewer Capacity Assurance Plan (CAP) to Stantec Consulting Services Inc. - CONSENT DECREE (L460-12) (Martin/Moloney)

This is a request to accept professional services agreement for the Sanitary Sewer CAP to Stantec Consulting Services Inc. The total compensation associated with this agreement is \$1,012,500. Funds are budgeted.

H [0465-12](#) Authorization to enter into a lease agreement with NAMI Lexington (KY), Inc. for space located at 498 Georgetown Street within the Black & Williams Neighborhood Center. (L465-12) (Hamilton)

This is a request to enter into a lease agreement with NAMI Lexington (KY), Inc. for space located at 498 Georgetown Street within the Black & Williams Neighborhood Center. The agreement will be for one (1) year beginning July 1, 2012 and ending on June 30, 2013, with an option of automatic extension for two (2) additional one (1) year terms. The Department of Social Services recommends that an annual rental rate of

\$3,918.66.

- I [0469-12](#) Authorization to exercise the option of internal advertisement of all vacant positions within the LFUCG through December 31, 2012. (L469-12) (Walters/Graham)
This is a request to exercise the option of internal advertisement of all vacant positions within the LFUCG through December 31, 2012. The goal is to save on advertising costs and provide internal promotional opportunities for current employees. There is no budgetary impact.
- J [0471-12](#) Authorization to accept award from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for ITS/CMS (Intelligent Transportation System/Congestion Management System) Traffic Improvements Project for FY 2013. (L471-12) (Gooding/Moloney)
This is a request to accept award in the amount of \$460,000 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for ITS/CMS Traffic Improvements Project for FY 2013. A local match of \$115,000 is required and has been requested in the Division of Traffic Engineering FY13 budget.
- K [0472-12](#) Authorization to approve correction to Resolution No. 90-2012 correcting maximum amount to be paid to Tactical Energetic Entry System, LLC for dynamic entry training for the Division of Police. (L472-12) (Gooding/Mason)
This is a request to approve correction to Resolution No. 90-2012 correcting maximum amount to be paid to Tactical Energetic Entry System, LLC, from \$35,000 to \$39,500 for dynamic entry training for the Division of Police. Funds are budgeted.
- L [0473-12](#) Authorization to submit application to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security under the 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program, requesting federal funds for replacement of a ladder truck. (L473-12) (Gooding/Mason)
This is a request to submit application to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security under the 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program, requesting federal funds in the amount of \$629,600 for replacement of a ladder truck. A local match of \$157,400 is required and has been requested in the FY13 budget.

Justice requesting federal funds for the purchase of bulletproof vests for the Fayette County Sheriff's Office-FY 2012. (L474-12) (Gooding/Mason)

This is a request to accept award in the amount of \$294.79 from the U.S. Department of Justice for the purchase of bulletproof vests for the Fayette County Sheriff's Office-FY 2012. The Sheriff's Office will provide a 50% match from their own budget.
