The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government recently completed a review of the Materials Recovery Facility located at 360 Thompson Road, Lexington, Kentucky. Based on this review, the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council recommended a \$15 per ton increase in the processing fee. This is the first increase in the processing fee since 1992.

In accordance with the executed Memorandum of Agreement between the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government and its Affiliates, page 6, XIII. TERM, LFUCG reserves the right to alter or amend any part of the MOA upon at least thirty (30) days advance written notice to Affiliate. This letter serves as formal notice for the amended MOA; thereby, increasing the processing fee to \$50 per ton on the incoming materials.
