) \$313,290.00 to the General Services District Fund from various accounts.

) \$1,505,514.00 to the Full Urban Services District Fund from various accounts.

) \$163,682.00 to the Sanitary Sewer Revenue and Operating Fund from various

accounts.

) Re-appropriations within the General Services District Fund, Full Urban

Services District Fund, Donation Fund, Affordable Housing and Homelessness &

Prevention Fund, Sanitary Sewer Revenue and Operating Fund, Water Quality

Management Fund, Landfill Fund, Right Of Way Program Fund, Extended School

Program Fund, Enhanced 911 Fund and the various grant funds that do not result in

changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these funds.

Section 2 - That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or

from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in "BUDGET SCHEDULE NO.

0006", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
