A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO PURCHASE A REPLACEMENT LIEBERT PRECISION COOLING UNIT, DRY COOLER AND PUMP, FROM CLIMATE CONDITIONING COMPANY, A SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$24,153.78.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:


Section 1 - That the Department of General Services, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized to purchase a replacement Liebert precision cooling unit, dry unit and pump, from Climate Conditioning Company, a sole source provider.

Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$24,153.78, be and hereby is approved for payment to Climate Conditioning Company from account #2602-707501-91013.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.

RE: Justification for Sole Source Certification with Climate Conditioning Company for Replacement Liebert Precision Cooling Equipment.

I am requesting Urban County Council approval to purchase a replacement Liebert precision cooling unit, dry cooler, and pump from Climate Conditioning Company for the Government Center Computer Server Room. This is a one time purchase. The cooling unit, dry cooler, and pump are being purchased to directly replace one of the four Liebert units that serve the computer server room.

Climate Conditioning Company is a sole source provider and the factory authorized regional sales outlet for Liebert equipment in this area. The existing Liebert unit that is being replaced is 15 years+ and is barely functioning. The computer server room houses critical computer operations for LFUCG. Inadequate cooling in the server room could have a detrimental effect on the computer servers which in turn would disrupt government operations.
