MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

MILITARY POLICE COMPANY A

AND

LEXINGTON DIVISION OF POLICE

REGARDING

RESPONSE ACTIONS IN THE EVENT OF A REPORTED ACTIVATION
OF A WEAPONS STORAGE ALARM OR INTRUSTION DETECTION SYSTEM

AUTHORITY

This Memorandum of Agreement is authorized under the provisions of Marine Corps Order 5530.14A, The Marine Corps Physical Security Manual.

PURPOSE

To Provide MILITARY POLICE COMPANY A a rapid armed response unit in the event of a security breach of weapons and/or ammunition.

AGREEMENT

LEXINGTON DIVISION OF POLICE shall send an armed patrolman to MILITARY POLICE COMPANY A, 151 Opportunity Way, Lexington, KY 40511, within 10 minutes of a telephone or automatic notification of a reported activation of any MILITARY POLICE COMPANY A's weapons storage alarms or intruder detection systems.

LEXINGTON DIVISION OF POLICE shall provide at least one patrol of MILITARY POLICE COMPANY A's fenced perimeter ever 24 hours.

MILITARY POLICE COMPANY A shall immediately notify LEXINGTON DIVISION OF POLICE during any instance of increased Force Protection Conditions as a result of local or national command directives. This immediate notification also includes all training exercises regardless of duration.
