SUBJECT: Sole Source Provider Adapt Pharma for Department of Social Services

Request: Council authorization to establish Adapt Pharma as a sole source provider of nasal Narcan for the SAMSHA FY2022 Congressional Directive Spending Projects Award for the Barrier Free Re-Entry and Recovery Initiative for the Department of Social Services at a cost not to exceed \$171,570.

Why are you requesting? On December 6, 2022 (Resolution No. 710-2022) Council authorized the acceptance of \$616,704 in federal grant funds from the United States Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration under the FY2022 Congressional Directive Spending Projects Award for increase collaboration with community stakeholders. This grant provides funding for the purchase of naloxone to serve the grant's primary objective of reducing overdose deaths in Lexington, Fayette County.

What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years? Estimated cost is \$171,570. No additional costs are anticipated.
