SUBJECT: Grant Application for the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project

Request: Council authorization to submit application and accept award, if offered, to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting federal funds in the amount of \$49,500 for the continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project for FY 2023. Match amount of \$5,500 is required.

Purpose of Request: The Division of Police has prepared a grant application for submission to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting federal funding for continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement project for Fiscal Year 2023. LFUCG is requesting federal funds in the amount of \$49,500 to continue the activities of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Division of Police. Match in the amount of \$5,500 is being requested in the FY23 General Fund for a total project cost of \$55,000. The source of these federal funds is the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program in the U.S. Department of Justice.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Cost in FY23 is \$55,000. Match in the amount of \$5,500 is being requested in the FY23 General Fund budget. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.
