2. All other terms and conditions of SC-628-1700002506 shall remain in effect.





**ATTACHMENT A
 SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET SUMMARY**

Scope of Work:

All federally-funded projects are set up in phases (design, ROW, utilities, construction). No work can begin on any phase of a project until the CABINET provides a written notice to proceed for that phase. Funding for this project will be programmed with FHWA as each phase is approved. As each phase of the project is programmed with FHWA a supplemental agreement will be sent to the project sponsor to add the funding and adjust the project end date. Any expenditure incurred by the project sponsor after the end date will not be eligible for reimbursement. If the project sponsor requires an extension, they must notify the Administering Office thirty (30) days before the project end date.

The scope of work includes PE, design, environmental and construction for the widening of east and westbound approaches of Manchester Street at the South Forbes Road intersection to provide dedicated left turn lanes from Manchester Street to northbound and southbound Forbes Road.

This supplemental agreement modifies the scope of work and budget to include construction activities and construction funding for the project.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. ONE (1) WITH THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET, ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$642,296.00 UNDER THE CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) PROGRAM, WHICH ARE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE TURN LANE PROJECT AT MANCHESTER STREET AND FORBES ROAD, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH OBLIGATES THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF \$160,574.00 AS A LOCAL MATCH, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute Supplemental Agreement No. One (1) with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, accepting additional Federal funds in the amount of \$642,296.00 under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, which are for the Construction Phase of the Turn Lane Project at Manchester Street and Forbes Road, the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$160,574.00 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.


Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
