SUBJECT: Hazard Mitigation Grant Extension for Lexington-Fayette Animal Care and

Control Facility Generator Project

Request: Council authorization to execute an amendment to the agreement with the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency extending the period of performance through June 30, 2024 for the Lexington-Fayette Animal Care and Control Facility Generator Project.

Purpose of Request: On February 6, 2020 (Resolution 55-2020), Council authorized the submission of an application to the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency requesting federal funding from FEMA's (Federal Emergency Management Agency) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Lexington-Fayette Animal Care and Control Generator. On February 10, 2022 (Resolution 062-2022), Council approved to accept an award in the amount of \$88,229.25 in federal funds from FEMA and \$14,116.68 non-federal share from the state, with a local match of \$15,293.07 to purchase a 150 KW Natural Gas Generator at Lexington-Fayette Animal Care and Control Facility.

The Kentucky Emergency Management Agency has offered LFUCG an extension through June 30, 2024.
