The current agreement stipulates a sliding scale with the daily average meals at 4201-4300.

The price agreed upon at this point in the scale is \$1.256 per meal. The new agreement would amend the current sliding scale point by \$0.124 per meal for the term of the new agreement as a result of CPI determinations. The new scale and pricing at this point in the scale would be \$1.387. Our team is extremely proud of the hard work and partnership that we have built together.
