## **CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT, made on the	day of		by and
between Lexington-Fayette Urban County	Government, acting 1	nerein called "OWNE	ER" and
Omni Commercial LLC, doing business as a	a corporation located in	the City of Lexington,	County
of Fayette, and State of Kentucky, hereinafter	called "CONTRACTOR		

WITNESSETH: That the CONTRACTOR and the OWNER in consideration of <u>three hundred ninety-six thousand seven hundred Dollars and No Cents</u> (\$396,700.00) quoted in the proposal by the CONTRACTOR, dated <u>March 4, 2020</u>, hereby agree to commence and complete the construction described as follows:

#### 1. SCOPE OF WORK

The CONTRACTOR shall furnish all the materials, supplies, machinery, equipment, tools, superintendence, labor, insurance, and other accessories and services necessary to complete the said project in accordance with the conditions and prices stated in the Proposal, the General Conditions, and the Special Conditions of the Contract, the Specifications, IonWave Q&A and Contract Documents therefore as prepared by Sherman Carter Barnhart Architects, PLLC and Shrout Tate Wilson Consulting Engineers PLLC for Fayette County Courthouse Appellate Renovation project. The Architect and Engineer are each under separate contracts with the Owner. Throughout the Contract Documents, wherever the term "architect" or "engineer" is used it shall be understood to apply to the appropriate design professional, namely the Architect or Engineer. The Contractor acknowledges that the Architect and Engineer, respectively, are responsible only for design that pertains to their respective specific work products / documents.

#### 2. TIME OF COMPLETION

The time period estimated and authorized by the OWNER for the proper execution of the Work by the Contract, in full, is hereby fixed as one hundred and five (105) calendar days to substantial completion and fifteen (15) calendar days thereafter to final completion for a total of one hundred and twenty (120) calendar days. The time shall begin in accordance with the Notice to Proceed provided by OWNER.

#### 3. ISSUANCE OF WORK ORDERS

Notice to begin Work will be given in whole or for part of the Work as determined by the OWNER pending the availability of funds. The order of construction will be as determined by the Architect and Engineer after consultation with the CONTRACTOR and the OWNER.

#### 4. THE CONTRACT SUM

The OWNER agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR in current funds for the performance of the Contract, as quoted in the proposal, subject to any additions and deductions, as provided therein.

#### 5. PROGRESS PAYMENTS

The OWNER shall make payments on account of the Contract, as provided in accordance with the General Conditions, as estimated by the Engineer, less the aggregate of previous payments.

#### 6. ACCEPTANCE AND FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment shall be due within ninety (90) days after completion of the Work, provided the Work be then fully completed and the Contract fully accepted.

Before issuance of final certificate, the CONTRACTOR shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Engineer that all payrolls, material bills, and other indebtedness connected with the Work has been paid.

If, after the Work has been substantially completed, full completion thereof is materially delayed through no fault of the CONTRACTOR, and the ARCHITECT and ENGINEER so certifies, the OWNER shall upon certificate of the ARCHITECT and ENGINEER, and without terminating the Contract, make payment of the balance due for that portion of the Work fully completed and accepted. Such payment shall be made under the terms and conditions governing final payment, except that it shall not constitute a waiver of claims.

#### 7. THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

The Advertisement for Bids, Information for Bidders, the General Conditions, Performance and Payment Bonds, Contract Agreement, Special Conditions, Technical Specifications, any and all Addenda, IonWave Q&A, and Proposal, and Plan Drawings form the Contract, and they are fully a part of the Contract as if hereto attached or herein repeated.

# 8. EXTRA WORK

The OWNER, without invalidating the Contract, may order extra work or make changes by altering, adding to or deducting from the Work, the Contract Sum being adjusted accordingly. All such Work shall be executed and paid for in accordance with the General Conditions, which is a part of this Contract.

#### **GENERAL SPECIFICATION NOTES:**

- 1. Unless noted otherwise, the following shall apply to all manufacturers listed throughout the construction documents: Subject to compliance with Contract Documents, manufacturers listed are approved as a manufacturer only. This does not imply that specific products supplied by such manufacturers have been reviewed and comply with requirements. It shall be the manufacturer's / contractor's responsibility to ensure that all requirements of the Contract Documents are met, including but not limited to the requirements for matching of specific finishes. "Standard" products that do not meet all requirements of the contract documents will not be accepted. As required to meet the requirements of the contract documents, custom products may be required from certain manufacturers. Unless noted otherwise by the Architect, Engineer, for specific substitutions, the Contractor supplying any substituted products shall be responsible for any additional costs associated with the use of such substitutions regardless of the trade or bid package affected.
- 2. As clarification, substitution requests are not required for product manufacturers that are not listed but that otherwise meet or exceed all requirements of the contract documents, expressed or implied, unless the specifications clearly indicate that only certain manufacturers shall be accepted as clarified below.
  - a. Some sections, after stating "Available Manufacturers" or "Available Products" or similar introduction, include the statement "but not limited to". Although specific manufacturers are listed, it is understood that not all products offered by available manufacturers may meet these requirements. Therefore, products not meeting all requirements will not be accepted. It is intended that other

- manufacturers shall be accepted provided they meet or exceed all requirements of the contract documents.
- b. The above also applies to specifications that indicate a "Basis-of-Design" product. In such cases, every requirement may not be listed in the specification. It shall be the responsibility of other manufacturers to verify the Basis-of-Design manufacturer requirements to determine whether their product meets or exceeds all requirements of the Basis-of-Design product. Where Basis-of-Design products are listed, such are indicated to establish required criteria. Basis-of-Design products shall not be ordered by the contractor in advance of formal submittals and approvals.
- c. Some sections state simply "Available Manufacturers" or "Available Products" or similar introduction, after which specific manufacturers are listed. In such cases, only those manufacturers may be supplied without a formal substitution request.
- 3. The Architect or Engineer shall not review individual submittal items for the same or related products separately. All submittals for the same product shall be submitted simultaneously as a single package.
- 4. The Contract Specifications and Contract Drawings are complimentary. The most stringent requirements from either shall apply.
