

RESOLUTION NO. 026 - 2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY RESEARCH FOUNDATION (UKRF) FOR THE PROVISION OF EVALUATION SERVICES FOR THE BARRIER FREE RE-ENTRY AND RECOVERY INITIATIVE (BFREE) UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE ADMINISTRATION FROM THE CONSOLIDATED APPROPRIATION ACT 2022, TO EXTEND THE PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE TO SEPTEMBER 29, 2024 AND INCREASE THE CONTRACT PRICE BY AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$29,346.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute an Amendment to the Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with the University of Kentucky Research Foundation (UKRF) for the provision of evaluation services for the Barrier Free Re-Entry and Recovery Initiative (BFREE) under the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Service Administration from the Consolidated Appropriations Act 2022, to extend the period of performance to September 29, 2024, and increase the contract price by an amount not to exceed \$29,346.00.

Section 2 – That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$29,346.00 in FY2024, be and hereby is approved for payment from account #3190-606105-71299, pursuant to the terms of the Amendment to the Agreement.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
