SUBJECT: Accept funds from JustFundKY 2020 Cliff Todd Endowment Grant

**Request:** Council Authorization to accept funds of \$5,000 from JustFundKY 2020 Cliff Todd Endowment Grant for Limestone/Short intersection art in downtown Lexington. There are no matching funds required.

**Purpose of Request:** The Mayor's Office has received a grant award of \$5,000 for Limestone/Short intersection art. As a part of Street and Roads paving and resurfacing project, the current crosswalk will be removed and replaced with a new rainbow design on Limestone. Streets and Roads will mill and resurface N. Limestone from Main Street to Short Street, including the intersection of N. Limestone and Short St. The milling will remove the existing pavement markings including the existing rainbow crosswalk design. LFUCG will fund the cost of a standard crosswalk installation for this location and this grant and any additional grants or donations will help fund the increased cost associated with the rainbow design.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$5,000 in Cliff Todd Endowment funds has been awarded for Fiscal Year 2021. No matching funds are required. Future years funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget Amendment 10709 is in process.
