SUBJECT: Grant application to the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services

Request: Council Authorization to submit a grant application requesting \$10,000 in state funds from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services for Fiscal Year 2020.

Why are you requesting?

The Division of Fire and Emergency Services has prepared an application requesting funding from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services in the amount of \$10,000 for Fiscal Year 2020. Funds will be used for the purchase of Mass Casualty Equipment for the training of EMT and Paramedic personnel within the division. This equipment will be used to teach continuing education to all firefighters in mass casualty procedures.

These are state funds pursuant to KRS 311A.155. No matching funds are required.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

\$10,000 in state funds is requested for Fiscal Year 2020. There are no anticipated costs in future years.

Are the funds budgeted: Funds are not yet budgeted. A budget amendment will be initiated if Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services approves the grant request.
