**SUBJECT: Fire Training Incentive for Fiscal Year 2023**

---

**Request:** Council authorization to accept award for Fire Training Incentive Grant in an amount up to \$3,595,162 for FY 2023 from the Commission on Fire Protection, Personnel, Standards, and Education for Training Incentives for Firefighters.

**Purpose of Request:** Fire Training Incentive funds are used to provide eligible firefighters with supplemental pay for participation in training programs. Supplemental pay in the amount of \$4,300 for each eligible firefighter (599 estimated sworn positions) is provided for a total of \$2,575,700. In addition, the program contributes up to 39.58% of that total towards the pension of participants, totaling \$1,019,462.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?** Grant funds for Fiscal Year 2023 total \$3,595,162 with no local match required. Future years' funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget amendment for Fiscal Year 2023 is in process.
