SUBJECT: Sole Source Resolution – Anritsu Service Monitor

Request:

A resolution recognizing Anritsu Americas Sales, Inc. as the sole source of a radio system Service Monitor manufactured by Anritsu.

Why are you requesting?

The Department of Public Safety owns two Anritsu Service Monitors specially designed and configured to trouble shoot issues with radio system equipment in use by government divisions. Radio Technicians in E911, Fire and Police assist each other with technical issues. This device for E911 ensures compatibility with currently owned accessories, integration features, training, and support in other divisions. E911 will use the device for radio tower site maintenance, radio base station maintenance and subscriber radio maintenance, primarily in the field. This brand of service monitor is the only one providing radio system coverage mapping, which is essential to managing the 800 MHz radio system used by multiple divisions.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?
