CHANGE ORDER TO AGREEMENT WITH THE KENTUCKY
TRANSPORTATION CABINET/DIVISION OF MAINTENANCE
FOR PROVISION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE
TATES CREEK ROAD SIDE WALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

On December 11, 2012 (Resolution 709-2012), Council approved execution of an agreement with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet/Division of Maintenance providing the LFUCG with necessary traffic signal equipment at a cost of \$54,033.48 for use in the Tates Creek Road Sidewalk Improvement Project. Actual cost of these materials is \$56,086.54. A change order in the amount of \$2,053.06 is being requested.

This project provides for the construction of sidewalks on both sides of the road from Enclave to Dove Run Road. Federal funds are from the federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality Program (CMAQ) allocation.
