Agreement in the amount of \$43,825 with M2D Design Group for the

Gainesway Trail Project

On August 27, 2009 (Ordinance 172-2009), Council approved the acceptance of federal funds from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for Gainesway Trail Project. This project provides for a shared use trail between the northern terminus at or near Centre Parkway and the southern terminus at or near Armstrong Mill Road. Federal funds in the amount of \$446,400 are from the federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality Program (CMAQ) allocation. 20% local match in the amount of \$111,600 will be documented from the value of land already owned by the LFUCG.

Division of Engineering issued RFP #26-2011, a qualifications-based selection process for procurement of an engineering design consultant for this project. Eight firms submitted statements of qualifications. A selection committee reviewed the responses and selected M2D Design Group as the most qualified firm with the ability and expertise to complete the work in a timely manner. The scope of work includes design, right-of-way acquisition, coordination of utility relocation, environmental and legal analyses, and the development of construction contracts. The negotiated cost of these services is \$43,825. Funds are budgeted as follows:
