SUBJECT: Athens Walnut Hill Pike No Through Truck Consideration

Per your request, Traffic Engineering reviewed Athens Walnut Hill Pike in regards to your request to prohibit through trucks on this road. Most of the properties along this road are residential or agricultural in nature. A No Through Trucks restriction would not apply to large trucks or local delivery vehicles traveling to those properties. Government related vehicles and buses are not included in this restriction.

Conclusion: Since most of the properties along Athens Walnut Hill Pike are zoned residential or agricultural and through truck traffic can and should utilize other rural arterials in this area, the Division of Traffic Engineering recommends the implementation of a No Through Trucks restriction on Athens Walnut Hill Pike between Old Richmond Road and Athens Boonesboro Road.
