The Division of Police has prepared a grant application for submission to the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security requesting funds in the amount of \$13,633 from the Law Enforcement Protection Program. If approved, these funds will be used for the purchase of a Throwbot XT. This is a robot designed for the US Military and police tactical teams. The Throwbot XT is a throwable micro-robot that enables operators to obtain instant video and audio reconnaissance either in an indoor or outdoor environment.

The Law Enforcement Protection Program is a fund established by Kentucky Revised Statutes 16.220 to assist local government police departments and county sheriffs with body armor and other equipment needs. This program is a joint collaboration between the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security and the Kentucky State Police. Matching funds are not required.
