**SUBJECT: Hazard Mitigation Grant Extension for Fayette County Flood Markers
Project**

Request: Council authorization to execute an amendment to the agreement with the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency extending the period of performance through June 30, 2024 for the Flood Markers Project.

Purpose of the Request: On April 28, 2022, (Resolution 193-2022) Council approved the acceptance of an award of \$16,500 in federal and \$2,640 in state funds from the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program to purchase and install 12 flood warning markers and signs in Fayette County. The total project cost is \$22,000.

The Kentucky Emergency Management Agency has offered LFUCG an extension through June 30, 2024.
