A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE FAYETTE COUNTY COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, THE KENTON COUNTY COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AND THE COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY, 28<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, FOR SERVICES UNDER THE 2011 PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD PROGRAM, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.00 FOR THE FAYETTE COUNTY COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, \$7,500.00 FOR THE KENTON COUNTY COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AND \$6,500.00 FOR THE COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY, 28<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL CIRCUIT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:


Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute Agreements, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorney's Office, the Kenton County Commonwealth Attorney's Office and the Commonwealth Attorney, 28<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, for services under the 2011 Project Safe Neighborhood Program.

Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$10,000.00 for the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorney's Office, \$7,500.00 for the Kenton County Commonwealth Attorney's Office and \$6,500.00 for the Commonwealth Attorney, 28<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, be and hereby is approved for payment to the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorney's Office, the Kenton County Commonwealth Attorney's Office and the Commonwealth Attorney, 28<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit from account #3140-505001-71299, pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
