Authorization to execute Amendment No. 3 to Agreement with the Bluegrass Area Development District, accepting additional funds in the amount of \$65,107.95, and amending service delivery/budget back-up for operation of the Senior Citizens

Center-FY 2015

On May 22, 2014 (Resolution No. 263-2014), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from Bluegrass Area Development District under Title III of the Older Americans Act for operation of the Lexington Senior Citizens Center in FY 2015. The Lexington Senior Citizens Center is a multi-purpose community focal point for services to persons 60 and older in Fayette County. Basic center operations include advocacy, counseling, education, health promotion, access to legal assistance, outreach, recreation, and telephone reassurance. LFUCG staff includes a center director, Social Worker, a staff assistant senior, a part-time receptionist, and two part-time van drivers.

On March 17, 2015 (Resolution No. 101-2015) Council approved Amendment No. 1 providing an additional \$18,357.54 in federal funds for a new award total of \$127,505.54.

On April 30, 2015 (Resolution No. 220-2015) Council approved Amendment No. 2 providing for updated budget and updated service delivery/budget back-up. There was no budget impact.

Bluegrass Area Development District has requested approval of Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement providing for an additional award of funds in the amount of \$65,107.95 for a new total of \$192,613.49.

Council authorization to execute Amendment No. 3 is hereby requested.
