SUBJECT Grant Application for Household Hazardous Waste Management Grant

Program

Request: Council authorization to submit an application to the Department of Environmental Protection—Division of Waste Management in the amount of \$100,000 for the support of a one-day household hazardous waste recycling event for Fayette County, the acceptance obligates the government to provide match in the amount of \$25,000.

Purpose of Request: The Division of Waste Management has prepared an application for submission to the state agency requesting funds for support of a one-day county-wide household waste recycling event. Funds will be used to contract with a vendor for appropriate disposal of hazardous waste. The Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Grants Program was established in 2006 by Senate Bill 50. KRS 224.43-505 (2)(c) specifies the establishment of a Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste management grants program.

Cost in this budget year and future budget years:

State funds in the amount of \$100,000 will be budgeted in Fiscal Year 2021. A match of \$25,000 is required and grant match has been requested for FY2021 in the Urban Services Funds (Fund 1115). Total cost will be \$125,000. No expenses are anticipated for future budget years.

Are funds budgeted? Budget amendment will be completed if awarded for Fiscal Year 2021.
