SUBJECT: Sole Source Provider Contract with Morpho Trak for purchase of

MorphoBIS Latent Expert Workstation

Request:

Request Council authorization to approve Morpho Trak as a sole source provider for purchase of the MorphoBIS Latent Expert Workstation for the Division of Police in the amount of \$95,475.

Why are you requesting?

The U.S. Department of Justice awarded Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government federal funds under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program for purchase of equipment to improve law enforcement activities. One of the approved activities is the purchase of an Automated Fingerprint Identification System Package (AFIS). Kentucky State Police is upgrading its AFIS to the next generation AFIS in November. As a result of the KSP upgrade, Lexington Police will no longer be able to submit with their current AFIS latent workstation. Morpho Trak is the only provider that sells a compatible workstation, which is the MorphoBis Latent Expert Workstation.

What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Cost in this budget year is \$95,475. There are no anticipated costs in future years.
