Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request authorization to execute an agreement awarding a Class B (Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant to Peppermill, LLC. This is for permeable pavement surfacing and educating the public, at a total cost of \$141,027.29.

Purpose of Request

This Grant provides funds to reduce and filter stormwater prior to releasing it into Town Branch Creek. The project also has an educational component that includes other businesses and stake holders through materials provided in the EPA National Menu of Stormwater Best Management Practices.

Project Cost in FY16 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$141,027.29 and is anticipated to be fully spent by FY17.
