WITH FRIENDS OF WOLF RUN FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF

ACTIVITIES UNDER THE WOLF RUN CREEK WATERSHED BASED

**PLAN** 

On September 28, 2012 (Resolution No. 576-2012), Council approved the acceptance of additional federal funds from the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet/Department for Environmental Protection/Kentucky Division of Water for the Wolf Run Watershed Based Plan. The goal of this project is the implementation of a watershed plan that the LFUCG has developed to reduce nonpoint source pollution in Wolf Run creek. An approved element of the project is public involvement by Friends of Wolf Run, a volunteer organization. The proposed agreement with Friends of Wolf Run provides for the use of federal funds in the amount of \$16,000 for conducting of watershed council meetings and conducting stream walk events. Friends of Wolf Run will also be responsible for documentation of grant match in the amount of \$16,000.
