Please be advised of the following clarifications to the above referenced Bid:

	Questions	Answers
1.	Is blasting allowed? I am not seeing anywhere in the plans or specs where it forbids it, but the girl who attended the pre-bid meeting for us told me that it was said in the pre-bid meeting that blasting is NOT allowed.	Blasting is not allowed.
2.	Is it mandatory to use a percentage of MBE/WBE/Veteran Owned subs in the bid or is this only a goal? The girl who attended the pre-bid meeting for us said that the subcontractor who is already contracted to do the concrete for the bridge is a MBE/WBE/Veteran Owned company etc. Can we use their amount as part of the MBE/WBE/Veteran Owned participation?	The MBE/WBE/Veteran Owned sub percentage is a goal. Documentation for the good faith efforts is required. The sole source sub is a Certified WBE contractor and can be used towards the achieving the goal.
3.	Are you going to give any information about the alternate landfill that will be required for the contaminated soil that will need to be removed on a portion of this project?	No. Contractor shall secure a landfill permitted to receive material contaminated as described in the bid documents. Verification of the permit will be required with manifests.

1. CLARIFICATIONS

2. DRAWINGS

- A. Sheet C-01 Existing Utilities #4 Delete the last two sentences.
- B. Sheet C-04 Manhole TB1_100 at the junction box should be labeled TB1_108. The existing sewer entering the box from the pipe bridge should be labeled 36* diameter as shown in the profile on this sheet.

3. SPECIFICATIONS

- A. Specification Section 02372 Erosion and Sediment Control:
 On page 02372-28, in paragraph 3.25, add the following items to the end of Paragraph 3.25 C, dealing with removal of spoil material from streets –
- No spoil material may be stored in a street right-of way (ROW) outside of approved daily
 work hours and not longer than 24 hours or overnight if work is suspended for the day.
 BMPs must be in place and maintained during all construction activity and in particular
 when spoil material is temporarily stored on a paved ROW. Emphasis shall be placed on
 minimizing discharge of any sediment or suspended solids and protecting inlet structures
 from any runoff.
- 2. Stone for trench backfill may be stored in the street if a lane closure permit has been obtained from the LFUCG Division of Engineering. Erosion and sediment controls (ESCs) shall be implemented to minimize the discharge of sediment onto open street lanes. Open street lanes shall be cleaned as needed to prevent the buildup of sediment on the street. ESCs shall also be implemented to minimize the discharge of sediment into curb inlets and catch basins.

- (2) If the contractor is found to have committed an unlawful practice under KRS 45.560 to 45.640, the contracting agency may cancel or terminate the contract, conditioned upon a program for future compliance approved by the contracting agency and the department. The contracting agency may declare such a contractor ineligible to bid on further contracts with that agency until such time as the contractor complies in full with the requirements of KRS 45.560 to 45.640.
- (3) The equal employment provisions of KRS 45.560 to 45.640 may be met in part by a contractor by subcontracting to a minority contractor or subcontractor. For the provisions of KRS 45.560 to 45.640, a minority contractor or subcontractor shall mean a business that is owned and controlled by one or more persons disadvantaged by racial or ethnic circumstances.

Any provision of KRS 45.560 to 45.640 notwithstanding, no contractor shall be required to terminate an existing employee upon proof that that employee was employed prior to the date of the contract.




