

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY AGREEMENT

The Law

Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (amended 1972) states that it is unlawful for an employer to discriminate in employment because of race, color, religion, sex, age (40-70 years) or national origin.

Executive Order No. 11246 on Nondiscrimination under Federal contract prohibits employment discrimination by contractor and sub-contractor doing business with the Federal Government or recipients of Federal funds. Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 states:

Section 2012 of the Vietnam Era Veterans Readjustment Act of 1973 requires Affirmative Action on behalf of disabled veterans and veterans of the Vietnam Era by contractors having Federal contracts.

Section 206(A) of Executive Order 12086, Consolidation of Contract Compliance Functions for Equal Employment Opportunity, states:


The Secretary of Labor may investigate the employment practices of any Government contractor or sub-contractor to determine whether or not the contractual provisions specified in Section 202 of this order have been violated.

The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government practices Equal Opportunity in recruiting, hiring and promoting. It is the Government's intent to affirmatively provide employment opportunities for those individuals who have previously not been allowed to enter into the mainstream of society. Because of its importance to the local Government, this policy carries the full endorsement of the Mayor, Commissioners, Directors and all supervisory personnel. In following this commitment to Equal Employment Opportunity and because the Government is the benefactor of the Federal funds, it is both against the Urban County Government policy and illegal for the Government to let contracts to companies which knowingly or unknowingly practice discrimination in their employment practices. Violation of the above mentioned ordinances may cause a contract to be canceled and the contractors may be declared ineligible for future consideration.





The LFUCG is requesting bids for the purpose of establishing a **Unit Price Contract for Woody Debris Removal in Drainageways** for the Division of Environmental Policy as per the attached Contract Documents for the period set forth within these Contract Documents and at the unit prices stated in the Proposal. Unit prices shall include all items and directions as stated in the Specifications.

The Bidder agrees to perform all the work described in the Contract Documents which shall include the furnishing of all labor, materials, supplies, services, all items of cost, overhead, taxes (federal, state, local), insurance, and profit for the contractor. Incidental items to the work are not listed.

Bidder must enter pricing in all line items below to be considered. **Bid will be awarded to one (1) bidder ONLY.** Terms of this Contract shall be for one (1) year from Urban County Council approval with the option to renew for up to one (1) additional year.

Bids shall be based on the quantities as listed in the column "Estimated Quantity". Contractor payment shall be based on documented actual quantities and the unit prices in the bid proposal. The LFUCG does not guarantee amount of work to be performed under this contract and the quantities listed below are only estimates.

The Contract shall be awarded to the lowest total bid (Items 1 & 2).
