

SUBJECT: Bid #92-2013 Hazardous Material Spill Clean Up

Bids to establish a price contract for Hazardous Material Spill Clean Up for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services were received in the Division of Central Purchasing on August 5, 2013.

Economic Engine notified two hundred fifteen (215) vendors with thirty-seven (37) vendors viewing the document. Two (2) bids were received.

Evergreen AES Environmental Services submitted the lowest bid on the majority of items. However, Evergreen AES Environmental Services took exception to the requirement to have a full team with all necessary equipment and supplies on site within one (1) hour. Evergreen can only meet this requirement during regular business hours.

PECCO Inc submitted the second lowest bid and took no exceptions to the one (1) hour mobilization requirement.

The bid of PECCO Inc meets bid specifications and is within budgetary constraints, therefore, the bid of PECCO Inc is recommended.
