A RESOLUTION INITIATING A TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE LAND SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE DEVELOPERS TO INSTALL PERMANENT SIGNS DENOTING "END OF PUBLIC MAINTENANCE" AT EACH LOCATION WHERE A PRIVATE STREET INTERSECTS OR OTHERWISE ABUTS A PUBLIC STREET AS DESCRIBED IN THE PROPOSED TEXT ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That a text amendment to the Land Subdivision Regulations to require developers to install permanent signs denoting "End of Public Maintenance" at each location where a private street intersects or otherwise abuts a public street as described in the proposed attached text is hereby initiated for Planning Commission consideration and recommendation.

Section 2 – That the draft proposed text amendment to the Land Subdivision Regulation is attached hereto and incorporated herein as an exhibit to this resolution.

Section 3 – That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
