Dear Ms. Clifford,

Petition cards were sent from Traffic Engineering via certified mail to the property owners on Glenn PI between Bryan Ave and N Limestone soliciting a response for or against the installation of four speed humps on Glenn PI. The letters were mailed on February 23rd, 2026, and a response was requested by Friday, April 17th, 2026.

A total of 34 postage paid petition cards, letters, and proposed speed humps location maps were mailed to all the property owners on Glenn PI. As the close of business Friday, April 17th, two mailings were returned as undeliverable, and 18 ballot cards were returned with votes. As two mailings were returned undeliverable, the total of eligible votes is reduced to the adjusted total of 32 votes.

Of the 18 petition cards returned:

- 17 votes, or 53 % of the adjusted total, were in favor of the installation of speed humps.
- 1 vote, plus 14 unreturned ballot cards, is 47% of the adjusted total, were opposed to the installation of speed humps.

With 53% of the votes cast in favor of installing speed humps which is more than the required minimum of 51% approval of the proposed action, the proposal to install speed humps on Glenn PI has passed. Therefore, speed humps will be installed on Glenn PI through the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program.

The neighborhood's share of the project cost is 20% of the overall cost which is a onetime cost of \$3,280 per the NTMP guidelines. Councilmember Tyler Morton has funds set aside to cover the neighborhood's cost share of \$3,280. Nothing additional will be needed from the neighborhood. LFUCG Traffic Engineering is providing 80% of the overall cost which is \$13,120. The cost per speed hump is \$4,100.
