**Request**

Request Council Authorization to submit an application requesting \$10,000 from the Kentucky Bicycle and Bikeway Commission's Paula Nye Memorial Bicyclist and Pedestrian Education Program for operation of a public education program for bike and pedestrian safety

**Why are you requesting:**

The LFUCG's Division of Planning has prepared an application for submission to the Kentucky Bicycle and Bikeway Commission requesting funding in the amount of \$10,000 to supplement a Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Marketing Campaign with the goal of reducing the incidence of collisions between bicyclists, pedestrians and motorists; increasing public awareness of the rules of the road; and fostering mutual respect among motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists.. No matching funds are required. The source of these funds is Kentucky's "Share the Road" specialty license plate program


**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?**
