	Overbrook Trunk is what delivers flow to the Overbrook PS and FM. It, by itself, does not eliminate any pump stations, it's just the conveyance infrastructure that allows the Hartland Trunks and Delong Road PS to have service.						
	Preservation of trees are incorporated into the alignment and construction of this project. An arborist will assess and identify trees that are considered specimen trees to be preserved as a part of this project. The plans and specifications will also include special provisions for the protection of existing tress to the maximum extent practicable. Design standards, including the use of riparian buffers, are incorporated into the alignment and construction of this project.						
	This project will provide energy efficiencies for LFUCG by providing the means to eliminate three (3) existing pump stations as part of the area plan and consolidating the flow into one (1) new pump station.						
	This project has to be built prior to taking four (4) SSO pump stations out of service. These SSOs are listed in LFUCG's consent decree and the elimination is contingent on this project. The pump stations being eliminated are:
