## JUSTIFICATION FOR WAIVER

Commissioner of Social Services Beth Mills recommends that Court Appointed Special Advocates of Lexington (CASA), a non-profit 501(c)3, pay no rent for usage of space in the Coleman Building. CASA's mission is through the power of volunteer advocacy, work to ensure that all victims of child abuse and neglect be given a chance to thrive in a safe, permanent home. CASA trained volunteers provide an independent voice for children by speaking for their best interest in the family court system.

CASA was established in 1986 as a program within the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government . Severe budgetary constraints required discontinuance of a funded volunteer manager and CASA incorporated as a non-profit agency in November 2003. CASA provides an unduplicated service to abused and neglected children in the Fayette County Court System.
