## Request:

Request Council authorization to accept award of state funds in the amount of \$7,750 from the Kentucky Fire Commission for purchase of a forcible door entry training prop for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services

## Why are you requesting?

The Kentucky Fire Commission has offered the LFUCG Division of Fire and Emergency Services state funds in the amount of \$7,750 for the purchase of a training prop designed to provide suppression personnel with hands on training regarding forcible door entry. The prop contains a variety of door security systems in use and can be rigged to simulate non-standard systems. The prop gives fire crews experience defeating actual systems they will encounter in the field.

## What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

\$7,750 in state funds is being budgeted for Fiscal Year 2016. No matching funds are required. No costs have been identified for future budget years.
