SUBJECT: Grant application for the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project

Request: Council authorization to submit application and accept award, if offered, to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting federal funds in the amount of \$75,000 for the continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project, and to execute agreement with the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorney's Office in the amount of \$90,300 for FY 2020, subject to availability of sufficient funds in Fiscal Year 2020.

Purpose of Request: The Division of Police has prepared a grant application for submission to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting federal funding for continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement project for Fiscal Year 2020. LFUCG is requesting federal funds in the amount of \$75,000 to continue the activities of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Division of Police and the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorney's Office in their attempts to arrest and convict the street level drug dealers. Match in the amount of \$35,000 is being requested in the FY20 General Fund for a total project cost of \$110.000. The Division of Police will use funds in the amount of \$19,700 for overtime expenses, and the Commonwealth Attorney will use funds in the amount of \$90,300 to support the employment of an assistant prosecutor. The source of these federal funds is the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program in the U.S. Department of Justice.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$35,000in local general fund match has been requested in the FY 2020 General Fund budget. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendment is in process for Fiscal Year 2020. If funds are approved, the agreement with the Fayette County Commonwealth Attorney's Office will be budgeted as follows:
