SUBJECT: Hazard Mitigation Grant Agreement for Revised Fayette County

Weather Radios Project

Request: Council authorization to execute an amendment to the agreement with the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency for the Fayette County Weather Radios Project.

Purpose of Request: On December 3, 2020, (Resolution 602-2020) Council approved the acceptance of an award of \$47,332.50 in federal and \$7,573.20 in state funds from the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program to equip all mobile homes located in a mobile home park in Fayette County with NOAA Weather All-Hazards radios, providing these residents with the opportunity to prepare themselves for severe weather. On May 5, 2022 (Resolution 233-2022), Council approved extension for the Fayette County Weather Radios to June 30, 2024.

The Kentucky Emergency Management Agency has revised LFUCG grant agreement and contract number.
