SUBJECT: Agreement with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for Sanitary Sewer Relocation for New Circle Road Widening Project

Request

In conjunction with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) New Circle Road from Georgetown Road to Boardwalk Widening Project, the Division of Water Quality (DWQ) is requesting approval of an agreement between KYTC and LFUCG to:

- Relocate / replace existing sanitary sewers within the proposed right of way at no cost to LFUCG, and
- Increase the conveyance capacity of the New Circle Road Trunk A Remedial Measures Project, which is also located within the proposed right of way, at a cost of \$149,912.94.

Purpose of Request

As part of the New Circle Road from Georgetown Road to Boardwalk Widening project, KYTC is relocating and/or reconstructing approximately 27 manholes and over 6,500 linear feet of pipe ranging from 3 to 36 inches in diameter. Since this work is necessitated by the project, the \$1,686,687.02 cost will be borne completely by the KYTC.

A portion of the widening project overlaps with a portion of the proposed New Circle Road (NCR) Trunk-A Consent Decree Remedial Measures project. While the Trunk-A project has not yet been initiated, DWQ recommends having this overlapping portion constructed by the KYTC widening contractor now to avoid future disruption of the widened road. The estimated cost for this segment of the NCR Trunk A is \$149,912.94. Because this work is a “betterment” to existing infrastructure located in the state right of way, LFUCG must pay the entire cost of the betterment.
