**SUBJECT: Hazard Mitigation Grant Extension for Thompson Road Recycling Center
Tornado Shelter Project**

Request: Council authorization to execute amendment to the agreement with the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency extending the period of performance through June 30, 2022 for the Thompson Road Recycling Center Tornado Shelter Project.

Purpose of Request: On October 12, 2017, (Resolution 606-2017) Council approved the acceptance of an award of \$70,208 in federal and \$11,233 in state funds from the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the construction of a tornado safe room at the Thompson Road Recycling Center.

On July 5, 2018, (Resolution 441-2018) Council approved extending the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency through June 30, 2020.

The Kentucky Emergency Management Agency has offered LFUCG an extension through June 30, 2022.
