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## Questions & Answers RFP #47-2014

1. If resumes for key personnel are included, do they count in the 20 page (max) limit?

ANSWER: Yes. However, to be clear, the 20 page limit does not include the required forms and paperwork as described in pages preceding the Scope of Engineering Services (which begins on Page 34 of the RFP).

2. Relative to the *Related Projects Chart* included in the RFP, is "Client Contract" supposed to be "Client <u>Contact</u>" (i.e. simply a typo) or do you really want the contract number?

ANSWER: This is a typo. Please enter the name of your client's primary contact for the referenced project.

3. Relative to the *Related Projects Chart* included in the RFP, please clarify what is meant by "% Contribution" for the Project Manager, Lead Project Engineer, and Other Key Personnel.

ANSWER: Specifically, we want to see what type and degree of involvement your personnel had on your referenced projects. Estimate the percent of overall work product they performed (Percent of overall billing is probably the easiest way to approach this.). An example might look like:

Project Manager	Wilma Waters	% Contribution – 20%
Lead Project Engineer	(blank)	% Contribution (blank)
Other Key Personnel	(blank)	% Contribution (blank)

In this case Wilma was the only employee of yours involved in that particular project who will be assigned to the Town Branch project.

Another example might look like:

Project Manager	(blank)	% Contribution (blank)
Lead Project Engineer	Sam Storm	% Contribution – 40%
Modeling Engineer	Ricky Rivers	% Contribution – 25%

In this case, the project manager for that particular project was someone else who will not be assigned to the Town Branch project. However, the other two employees will be assigned to the Town Branch project, and have experience you feel is pertinent. You may use descriptive titles like "Modeling Engineer", even if that's not their official title. In this instance, their role and function with respect to the cited project is more important to us than their official title.
