A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD OF AN ADDITIONAL \$163,705.57 IN FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION UNDER THE SHUTTERED VENUES OPERATOR GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE KENTUCKY THEATER, AND RATIFYING, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, THE MAYOR'S PRIOR ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD OF AN ADDITIONAL \$47,409.31 IN FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE SMALL BUSINESS

ADMINISTRATION UNDER THE SHUTTERED VENUES OPERATOR GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PAM MILLER DOWNTOWN ARTS CENTER, MOONDANCE AND BALLET UNDER THE STARS, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE

THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE

GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a grant award of an

additional \$163,705.57 in federal funds from the Small Business Administration under the

Shuttered Venues Operator Grant program for the Kentucky Theater, the acceptance of

which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 – That the Urban County Government hereby ratifies the Mayor's prior

acceptance of a grant award of an additional \$47,409.31 in federal funds from the Small

Business Administration under the Shuttered Venues Operator Grant program for the Pam

Miller Downtown Arts Center, Moondance and Ballet Under the Stars, the acceptance of

which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 3 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 97-21, the Mayor is

hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County

Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account

appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the grant budget

previously established for this grant.

Section 4 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
